The First Church of Christ, Scientist in Boston, Massachusetts, also known as The Mother Church, is the home of the worldwide Christian Science Church. Christian Science was founded in 1879 by New Englander Mary Baker Eddy (1821–1910), who was a devout student of the Bible and the teachings of Christ Jesus.

The *How Do You See the World?* experience with the *Mapparium*™ globe is located inside the lobby of the Christian Science Publishing House, which is situated on the 13.5-acre Christian Science Plaza and houses The Christian Science Publishing Society, The Mary Baker Eddy Library, and the Church's administrative offices. The Publishing Society publishes the church's religious magazines, as well as *The Christian Science Monitor*, a global news organization and winner of seven Pulitzer Prizes, whose mission is "to injure no man, but to bless all mankind."
