Important Pricing Update

On August 1, the CSPS adjusted wholesale and retail prices for many of our Reading Room products. The new pricing responds to increased production costs and simplifies and standardizes our catalog by rounding retail prices to even dollar increments. It also responds to increased prices to CSPS from third-party sellers of Bible study resources and marking supplies.

On average, the updated pricing increases Reading Room profits and also makes the entire catalog more consistent. For example, the price of the 1932 Hymnal previously varied significantly by language. The adjustments standardized both the Reading Room and suggested retail prices across all languages.

Around half of the products sold by CSPS changed prices. To assist you with updating your prices and point-of-sale systems, please refer to [this list](#) of products with price changes.
